


# **Introduction to Upanishads**


1) Person seeks emotional, financial, social security. He also seeks comforts, pleasure, prosperity.

#### **Guru Stotram:**

अखण्डमण्डलाकारं व्याप्तं येन चराचरम् । तत्पदं दर्शितं येन तस्मै श्रीगुरवे नमः ॥२॥ Akhanndda-Mannddala-Akaaram Vyaaptam Yena Cara-Acaram |

Tat-Padam Darshitam Yena Tasmai Shrii-Gurave Namah ||2||

(Salutations to the Guru) Whose Form is an Indivisible Whole of Presence, and By Whom is Pervaded the Moving and the Non-Moving Beings, By Whom is Revealed (out of Grace) That Feet (of Indivisible Presence); Salutations to that Guru. [Verse 2]

- Guru shows reality to you as your own self Tat Tvam Asi.
- Prasna Upanishad :

This is Brahman – nothing greater than this.

• Katha Upanishad:

महतः परमव्यक्तमव्यक्तात्पुरुषः परः । पुरुषान्न परं किंचित्सा काष्ठा सा परा गतिः ॥११॥

Mahatah param-avyaktam, avyaktat-purusah parah, Purusan-na param kincit, sa kastha sa para gatih II 11 II

Beyond the great (Mahat) is the unmanifested (Avyaktam). Beyond the Avyaktam (Prakrti) is the Purusa; beyond the Purusa there is nothing; that is the end; that is the highest goal. [I - III - 11]

- In 11, Svetasvataro Added.


#### What are Vedas?






# What is purpose of Karma?

# How to get Rid of restless Mind?




# Why Vikshepa?

From this world.


# f) Poornam Adaya:
